<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Counting in order 1-10</li> <li>Using number names in order in familiar contexts up to 10 including '0'</li> <li>Counting reliably up to 6 objects</li> <li>Introduction to Numicon</li> <li>Understanding how to represent a number in different ways</li> <li>Finding 1 more than a given number</li> <li>Using simple mathematical language to describe shapes</li> <li>Using shapes to make pictures and patterns</li> <li>Sorting</li> <li>Problem solving</li> </ul>		

<b>Communication and Language</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Developing listening skills</li> <li>Understanding of simple instructions</li> <li>Talking about themselves and their families and about the people who help them both in and out of school</li> <li>Using language to act out roles</li> </ul>

<b>Expressive arts &amp; design</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drawing/painting - self portrait, our families</li> <li>• Colours/ colour mixing</li> <li>• Songs about ourselves</li> <li>• <b>Role play</b> - home corner</li> <li>• Making emergency vehicles.</li> <li>• Painting pictures of emergency vehicles/people who help us.</li> </ul>
<b>Physical</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Developing spatial awareness</li> <li>• Group games; ring, group and playground games</li> <li>• How we feel after exercise</li> <li>• Gaining control over fastenings when getting dressed and undressed for P.E sessions</li> <li>• Using a correct pencil grip and gaining control with mark making implements</li> <li>• Using and holding scissors correctly</li> <li>• Drawing skills - draw themselves &amp; family</li> </ul>
