Year 1 weekly news

As part of our Summer 1 and 2 topic – Paws, Claws and Whiskers (PCWs) the children have been looking at the text "Mog on fox night". We started our literacy journey by reading the story and answering some key questions about what happened. Then we created a storyboard and broke the story down into x3 parts – the beginning, middle and end. We then spent time using and applying our Year 1 key skills to sequence sentences to form the narrative. The children really enjoyed learning this story and finding out all about Mog.

In Science the children have been learning all about the different animal groups and what animals need to have to fit into the different groups.

The Year 1 teachers have loved finding out about all of the children's favourite animals and we have seen some super work done at home through videos on Tapestry for homework.
