We are an Operation **Encompass School**



We are part of a project that is run jointly between schools and Leicestershire Police. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced or witnessed, any domestic abuse.

Operation Encompass has trained a member of the school staff, (DSL) to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to ensure that the school can make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have experienced a domestic abuse incident. We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
