This week we have had less Covid 19 cases in school. If your child develops COVID-19 symptoms, they must self-isolate immediately and get a PCR test, even if their symptoms are mild. This is because many people experience mild symptoms from COVID-19, but may still pass on the virus to others. The most important symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following: • a new continuous cough • a high temperature • a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia) If your child is symptomatic, they should self-isolate at home while they get a PCR test and wait for the results. They must self-isolate if they test positive, from the day their symptoms started and the next 10 full days, or from the day the test was taken if they do not have symptoms and the next 10 full days. Thank you so much to all the parents who have supported us by following these regulations. Have a lovely weekend everyone.
