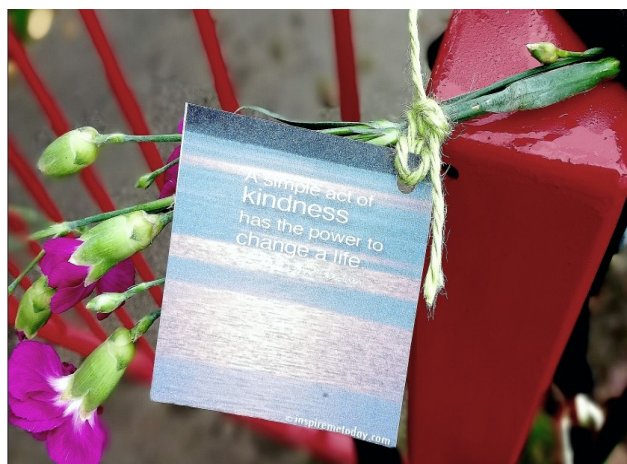
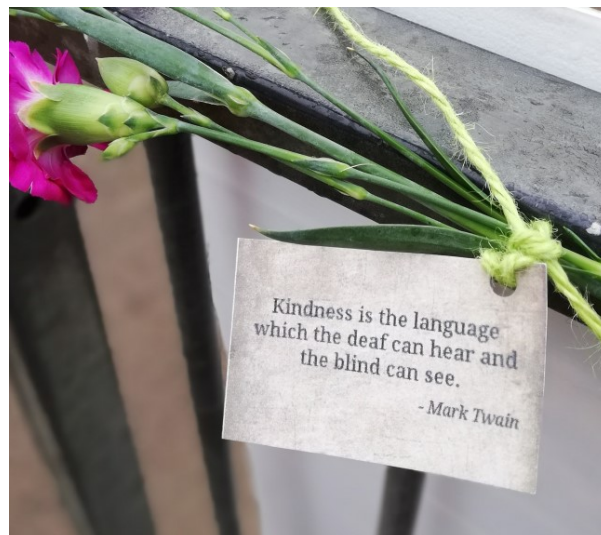
Prayer Group Walk
