

Year 5 - Roller Coasters

Year 5 have been loving their topic on Scream Machine and learning all about different forces involved in roller coasters. We have learnt lots about gravity, friction, momentum, air resistance and even kinetic and potential energy. To apply our learning, we were set the challenge to create a roller coaster that involved a loop the loop using foam strips (pipe insulation). We used marbles as our carriages and came across many problems we needed to solve along the way.

After lots of trial and error, we quickly realised we need to have a very steep drop at the beginning in order to build up enough momentum. If we put the masking tape on the track this increased friction and slowed our marble down and also if we placed the loop the loop too far away from the steep drop, the marble ran out of momentum, resulting in a crash.

We all had so much fun doing this and now are roller coaster experts.
