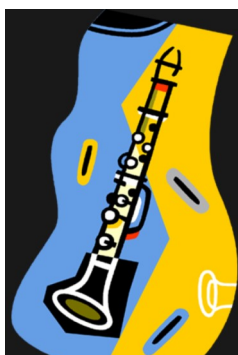
Year 1 news

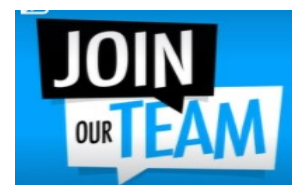
