On Monday, Miss Parrott accompanied Mr Swingler to Manchester where he was awarded a National STEM Teaching award. This was a huge achievement as thousands of other applicants were considered from across the country.

The presentation highlighted how he has gone above and beyond to support staff in the school (and wider afield) to feel competent and confident in the use of an array of technology in lessons in order to inspire and further children's learning.
