Little Princess Trust Fundraising

On Tuesday afternoon one of our pupils went into the Julian's Hair Salon in Kibworth with hair that came down to her waist. She loved to put her long dark brown locks into plaits, ponytail, bun or just free flowing. She left the salon having had 9 inches cut off and feeling very light headed!

The hair that was cut has been sent to the Little Princess Trust which is a charity that make real hair wigs for children and young adults, who have lost their own hair through cancer treatment or other conditions. The wigs are fitted and provided free of charge for the children and can be styled, curled etc to provide styles and original looks. She was keen to help when she heard about the trust and the trauma for children who loose their hair.



The making of the wigs is obviously very skilled and comes at a high cost, even though the hair is donated.
