### A letter to families

Dear all,

The KPA is excited to share more details about the Summer Fair on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June from 3.30-7.00pm. This is the first fair held at the school for several years and whilst we are all very excited we will also need a lot of volunteers to make this event work well for everyone.

The fair will consist of food and drink areas, an entertainment area, inflatables and games. There will also be classic fair stalls with different games to participate in. A couple of stalls, such as the Teddy Tombola, will provide the winners with a prize directly, while others will give winners a mark on their stamp card. The card can be exchanged for a prize – the more stamps you collect, the better the prize you can claim.

Each year group has been allocated a stall and we are hoping that the families of children in those year groups can help by running those stalls. All equipment for the stalls will be provided and the KPA will help with collection donations of prizes for those stalls which require them. We will also provide instructions on how to run the stall.

All we are asking is that volunteers man the stalls in pairs for a minimum of 30 minutes and we have created online sign-up sheets (as we do for the disco etc.) so that you can book your slot. Squash and biscuits will be available for volunteers and any little 'helpers' during the event. Water is free for all attendees. Please let us know if your child/children will be helping you when you are manning your year stall and we will provide a snack for them during this time. We want everyone to feel welcome and supported – if you have any accessibility requirements, just let us know when you sign up so we can make any necessary arrangements.

We will also need help with setting up the fair and tidying up after and have created sign-ups for these as well. Unfortunately no pre-school children will be able to help with setting up the fair (i.e. before 3.30pm)

As this is such a big event for the KPA, and will require lots of parent volunteers to make it enjoyable for all, we would like to thank volunteers who can give a little extra time at the event:
